These roles support and work cross functionally with Materials, Supplier Quality, Operations, Parts Distribution, Indirect & Direct Sourcing, and Advanced Manufacturing Engineering allowing a broad view of the business. Co-ops in Sourcing have the opportunity to enhance their leadership, project management and communication skills while being exposed to senior leadership and team networking.
